




Dear Ms. Noble and Mr. Brock:

My staff and I have reviewed your June 10, 2010 request to negotiate new Program Year 2010 (PY10) Entered Employment Rates for Oklahoma's Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Adult, Dislocated Worker and Wagner Peyser (WP) programs and negotiated new goals with your staff. This letter confirms the agreed-upon negotiated levels of performance for those three measures for PY10. The enclosed chart summarizes PY10 WIA and WP negotiated levels, incorporating the three new targets and nine extended targets.

Oklahoma has already been granted an extension to its current Strategic State Workforce Investment Plan into PY10. Therefore, as indicated in Training and Employment Guidance Letter No. 23-09, this letter will constitute a modification to that State Plan for PY10. Please incorporate the agreed-upon performance levels into the plan.
