New and Expanding Oklahoma Companies Second Quarter Report 2026

Oklahoma Department of Commerce – Research Division

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The New and Expanding Oklahoma Companies initiative is intended to identify, track, and communicate publicly announced business location and expansion activity within the State of Oklahoma. The program supports economic development awareness by providing a standardized, statewide view of investment activity, job creation potential, and industry growth trends based on publicly available information and program participation data. This initiative is informational in nature and is designed to promote transparency and general economic insight rather than to serve as a certification, endorsement, or verification of specific company activity.

Quarterly Report Purpose

This quarterly report is issued by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to provide a periodic summary of publicly announced new and expanding business activity across the state. The report compiles available data related to company announcements, projected job creation, and anticipated investment for informational and general reference purposes. It is intended to present a consistent, high-level overview of economic development activity within a defined reporting period and does not constitute a comprehensive or exhaustive accounting of all business activity occurring within the State of Oklahoma.

Government Authority

This report is prepared and published by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce pursuant to its authority to administer and support economic development programs within the State of Oklahoma. The Department operates in accordance with applicable state and federal laws, including but not limited to its role as a recipient and pass-through entity for federal financial assistance where applicable. Program references within this report, including incentive programs and economic development initiatives, are administered under governing statutes, administrative rules, and applicable federal requirements, including 2 CFR Part 200 where federal funds are involved.

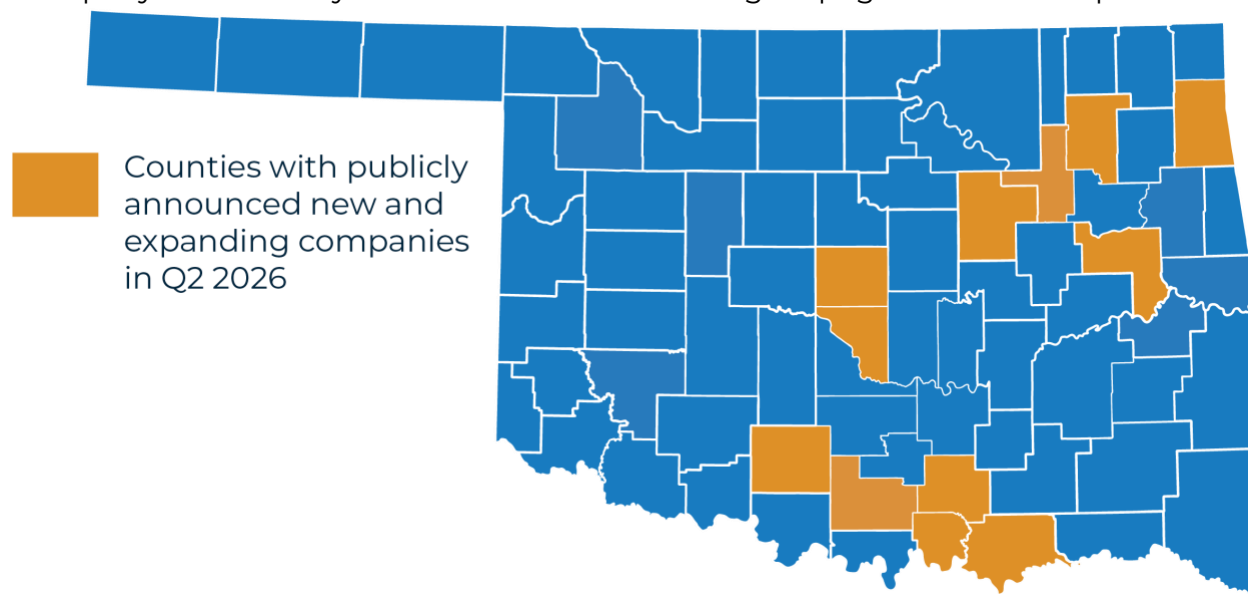

Highlights

In the second quarter of 2026, there were a total of 19 announcements or Pooled Finance award letters for new and expanding companies statewide with a potential investment of \$2.07 billion. Of those, five companies are establishing a new presence in Oklahoma. At least 685 new jobs are expected from all announcements.

Notes

Companies making public announcements about new locations or expansion investments are included in this report. Also included are companies receiving Business Expansion Incentive Program (BEIP) or Rapid Community Response Program (RCRP) incentives. The above summary figures include anticipated new jobs and investment amounts from these programs. Bank branches, health care facilities, retail and hospitality locations and real estate developments on their own are generally not included in this report. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce does not include new locations or expansions in the report or release individual company investment amounts or new job figures unless they are made public by the company.
