

## Notice of Virtual Town Hall for CDBG Disaster Recovery Home Rehabilitation Program (DR-4438)

On January 27, 2020, a new notice of a Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) allocation was released by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in Federal Register Notice<sup>1</sup> (Vol. 85, No. 17, Page 4683 Public Law 116-20). Under this Federal Register Notice, Oklahoma is eligible to receive an allocation of \$36,353,000 in disaster recovery funds for necessary expenses for activities authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 *et seq.*) to address long-term recovery needs, particularly in the area of housing recovery focusing on low and moderate-income beneficiaries.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development approved the State's CDBG-DR Action Plan for Substantial Amendment on August 19, 2021. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security are seeking public feedback on a Home Rehabilitation Program using CDBG-DR funds.

The proposed program would affect the following counties in Oklahoma: Alfalfa, Canadian, Cherokee, Craig, Creek, Delaware, Garfield, Kay, Kingfisher, Le Flore, Logan, Mayes, Muskogee, Noble, Nowata, Okmulgee, Osage, Ottawa, Pawnee, Payne, Pottawatomie, Rogers, Sequoyah, Tulsa, Wagoner, Washington, and Woods.
