

**ODOC WPN 22-1
PY2022 NEAT/MHEA Fuel Costs**

The following table shows average fuel prices for Oklahoma with the most data available (from www.eia.gov). Every agency's setup library must reflect these prices.

If regional prices are significantly different, agencies may apply to ODOC for an exemption to use different fuel costs. Sufficient data and supporting documentation must be submitted with the request.

Fuel switching is not an allowable cost in program year 2022.

Electricity	\$0.12 per KWH ¹
Natural Gas	\$12.48 per MCF ²
Propane	\$2.72 per Gallon ³
Wood	\$172 per Cord ⁴
Other (wood pellets)	\$20.00 per MMBTU ⁵
