Purpose: To announce new county assignments for Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program and Department of Human Services Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program funds.

1. On June 8, 2020, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) released a Request for Application for 15 (fifteen) unserved weatherization counties and 1 (one) partially unserved county (Tulsa county has historically been divided between two different agencies). Applicants had until July 10, 2020 to submit an application.
2. ODOC appreciates all applicants that submitted a proposal. ODOC is pleased to announce the following counties have been awarded to the following weatherization service providers:

Little Dixie	Coal, Pontotoc, Bryan, Carter, Love
CDSA	Kay, Logan, Noble, Payne

3. The following counties remain unserved as of the date of this memo:
 - Creek, Lincoln, Osage, Pawnee, Okmulgee, Okfuskee, Pottawatomie, Tulsa (partial), Hughes, Seminole, McIntosh

ODOC will continue to work with the network and stakeholders to ensure both short term and long term program solutions so that low income families in all 77 (seventy-seven) counties in Oklahoma have access to critical weatherization services.
