Purpose: To announce new county assignments for Department of Energy Weatherization Program (DOE WAP) and Department of Human Services Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program funds.

1. In November 2022, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) released a competitive Request for Application to restructure the service regions for the Weatherization program to ensure all 77 counties were being served. At the time of release, multiple counties in Oklahoma had been without Weatherization services for over a year. Applicants had until January 13, 2023 to submit an application.
